Front and rear windows; will they be wooden sash type, including the new rear dormer, as at No 46? The rear dormer drawing does not show sash windows. Will the rear doors/windows to the new kitchen be wooden too, or metal? I appreciate that as No 46 have built up the garden wall to above ground floor height, that the kitchen extension is more easily feasible for the new owners. The Victorians designed these houses with the plumbing at the rear, with the middle floor front as the the principle room. Personally I think it is a shame therefore to make this into a bathroom and study, but that is only my view. I do endorse all of the comments from No 40 Croftdown Rd. Will the rear fixed glass window(s) be opaque or clear? Tiles are mentioned in the drawings; the roofs are mainly the original Welsh slate.</p> <p>Finally, I wish the new owners well in their new home and welcome them to our Conservation Area.</p> <p>Thank you, Eileen Willmott</p>
