Thank you for your consultation dated 19 May 2015.

The Greater London Archaeological Advisory Service (GLAAS) provides archaeological advice to boroughs in accordance with the National Planning Policy Framework and GLAAS Charter.

Having considered the proposals with reference to information held in the Greater London Historic Environment Record and/or made available in connection with this application, I conclude that the proposal is unlikely to have a significant effect on heritage assets of archaeological interest.

Although the site lies within an Archaeological Priority Area the works are too small scale to





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be likely to cause significant harm in this location.

No further assessment or conditions are therefore necessary.
