When our own application for a dormer window was rejected by Camden in the 1990s we submitted an alternative design that gave us less space, but a small indented balcony entirely within the profile of the roof slope. We value this, and the proposed new dormer window at number 41 would effectively abut it, just the other side of the dividing parapet, blocking out the view in that direction. A second concern is that the scale and bulk of the proposed dormer, as large as can be fitted on that side of the roof, is out of keeping with others locally and with that on the other (east) side of 41. | | |
