Summary of representations  (Officer response(s) in italics)	The owner/occupier of Flat 1, 1 Stone Buildings, Lincoln's Inn has made the following comments:  Many of the residential properties to the rear of application site have habitable rooms overlooking the site. The location of the air conditioning units was queried. The main cause for concern is that the new units should be quieter than the existing or located within acoustic screening.  Officer's response								
	A response was sent by email 01/05/205, informing the owner/occupier that the current application refers to the air conditioning units on the rooftop, and that a further planning application was submitted regarding replacement air conditioning units on the first and fourth floors (reference 2015/2458/P).								

Their concerns/comments have therefore been logged under both applications

The noise impact assessment submitted with this application demonstrates that the proposed units comply with Camden's noise standards, and it is not considered that the new units cause harm to neighbouring amenity in terms of loss of privacy, daylight, sunlight or outlook.
