PLEASE CONFIRM THAT THE LICENCE IS STILL A1, as the planning site shows no decision on this application.</p> <p>I oppose this application on the grounds of failure to notify concerned parties and of the lack of details. I wish to be notified of any further developments and committee meetings.</p> <p>1. No notification has been posted on or near the premises nor sent to neighbours (or the residents' association), including the freeholders who both live at this address, of which I am one. As a result, the period open for comments is unacceptably short, running for only 21 days, from 13 Nov. to 4 Dec: I only found this because of a neighbour's vigilance, without which I would have been deprived of any knowledge of this important change of use. The application should therefore be resubmitted with proper notification.</p> <p>2. No details of what the change of use would entail have been included in this application: it should therefore be resubmitted with such details as how ventilation (which is basic: is it adequate for cooking?) and possibly fire escape routes (only one exit), along with any other design, health or safety issues, would be addressed.</p> <p>3. Another missing detail is whether they are applying for a liquor licence, which has been refused in the past for this premises on the grounds of neighbours' opposition.</p> <p>4. Another missing detail is hours of business: evening opening would cause a nuisance to neighbours in this residential street.</p> <p>5. Depending on such factors as licencing and opening hours, this application could change the character of the street, a Conservation Area, residential with mainly shops.</p> <p>I therefore object to this inadequate application and wish to attend any committee that might consider it.</p>
