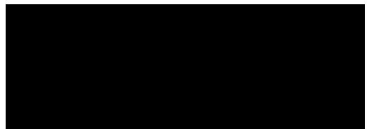

Your comments on the planning application

The frontage block of the Royal Ear Hospital on Capper Street is of significant architectural and historic interest, and makes an important contribution to this part of the Bloomsbury Conservation Area. It is by an accomplished architect (Wimperis, Simpson & Guthrie) and is a highly distinctive example of 1920s architecture which the borough should be seeking to protect and not destroy.

I find it difficult to believe that an experienced conservation officer who values Camden's built heritage could have sanctioned its destruction. This scheme should be
