It will not be in keeping with the architecture of the surrounding houses.</p> <p>The installation of the staircase will result in a loss of daylight into the alleyway of our property also a loss of daylight into our kitchen. The alleyway is narrow and is therefore already quite dark, so any further reduction in light will have a big impact. The staircase will also result in a loss of privacy as the staircase will be positioned adjacent to our kitchen.</p> <p>I don't understand why a fire escape is required, as there aren't any installed in the surrounding properties. The only reason I can think of is whether Vicky is looking to change the house into 2 flats, however I couldn't find this in the plans.
