1 Reason for granting permission:

Full details of the proposed acoustic barrier have been submitted including its specification, location and full calculation details to show the expected attenuation.

The acoustic barrier would comprise of a perforate steel modular acoustic panel at



a height above the plant machinery. It would fully enclose the plant equipment and is considered to be acceptable in appearance. A plant noise calculation has been submitted and the barrier has been laboratory tested with the contribution due to sound transmitted through the barrier calculated as negligible. The details have been assessed by the Council's Noise Officer and are considered acceptable. Therefore, the submitted details are in accordance with the condition.

No objections were received prior to making this decision. The site's planning history and relevant appeal decisions were taken into account when coming to this decision.

As such, the proposed details are in general accordance with policies CS 5 and CS14 of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Core Strategy, and policies DP24, DP26 and DP28 of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Development Policies. The proposed development also accords with policies 7.4 and 7.6 of The London Plan March 2015, consolidated with alterations since 2011; and paragraphs 14, 17 and 56-66 of the National Planning Policy Framework.

The applicant is advised that the following condition associated with planning permission 2012/1897/P dated 25/06/12 require the submission of further details: 4 (Details, samples).

In dealing with the application, the Council has sought to work with the applicant in a positive and proactive way in accordance with paragraphs 186 and 187 of the National Planning Policy Framework.
