We live in an end of terrace block, two doors away from the proposed excavation, with very limited parking available. I gather from work at 86 that considerable disruption was caused by skips, belts, construction vehicles and skips. Continuous drilling, enormous noise, vibration, dirt, with cracking floors, walls and garden subsidence, over many months, possibly as much as one year. I gather the noise and pollution issues are very great and would test the most generally neighbours sanity/health. My wife, Mrs Pamela Lucas, suffers from emphysema and bronchiectasis, coughing constantly and has frequent chest infections, needing specialist care, constantly monitored. Unfortunately we live in a polluted area already and I am sure that her health would deteriorate further if this were to go ahead, she is constantly breathless and the added dust would be very detrimental to her fragile health (All medical records are readily available). I myself have cardiac & pulmonary issues to consider.

We live at number 66 Hawtrey Road immediately behind and adjacent to the site of the proposed works at 56 Hawtrey Road and most strongly object to the proposed basement extension. Basement extensions cause appalling disruption to the lives, not only of the immediate neighbours, but more generally in the road. The immediate neighbours suffer damage to their properties from vibration and movement. Both my wife and I work from home and we would find it impossible to continue working because of the prolonged drilling and other construction noise from number 56 which will last for a considerable time. The works will require large numbers of skips to accommodate the spoil together with many vehicles parked on site by the construction crews as well as many heavy construction movements by road. All this will cause further noise and disruption in a small already crowded road with limited parking. It has been demonstrated elsewhere in Camden that basement excavations cause enormous hardship to those in the vicinity. I am also aware that Kensington and Chelsea and Westminster boroughs have recognised the human and physical damage caused by basement excavations. I urge the Planning Department to refuse this application on the grounds of excessive noise, vibration and dirt together with increased and disruptive traffic and serious parking issues.
