I write to let you know of the huge body of support for the proposals at St. Anthony's School, Hampstead.

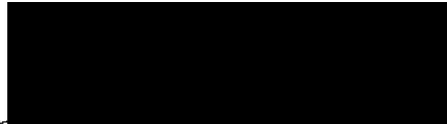
The school proposes to expand into a building adjacent to their existing facility on Arkwright Road. This will bring more school places and will also open up the school to girls.

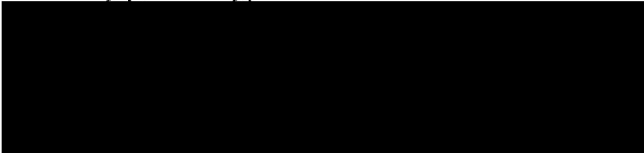
