

## North-west corner of grounds

Row of beech trees (lapsed hedge)

- These trees are believed to have been planted in the mid to late 1950's.

- All of the trees bases are within 50mm-200mm of the boundary wall with the neighbouring property.

- The land on the Beechwood property side is 80cm-1m above the neighbouring property, The Coach House, driveway.

- The trees have been viewed from the front boundary wall travelling south.
