I have looked into the circumstances concerning the redevelopment of the premises known as 11 Rosslyn Hill NW3 5UL and its lengthy, maybe permanent impact on the adjoining Air Studios building and wish to lodge a formal objection to the applicant's plan to create further subterranean space under 11 Rosslyn Hill NW3 5UL for the following reasons:

 Air Studios is one of only two buildings remaining in England that has the space and facilities available to accommodate recording requirements for large performing artist groups, including full-size orchestras and big bands. It also has ample off-street parking areas sufficient to accommodate the large types of vehicles that are necessary to accompany such visits to this facility so residents' nearby parking spaces are not compromised.

- If this development goes ahead it will impact greatly upon the studios' ability to
 provide the recording facilities needed since the noise created will cause major
 periods of downtime (i.e. recordings will not be possible when the works are actually
 being carried out due to the noise and vibration it will certainly cause to the studios'
 ability to function adequately).
