The use of the outdoor area hereby permitted shall not be carried out outside the following times 10:00 - 22:00 Mondays to Saturdays and 10:00 - 22:00 on Sundays and Bank Holidays.

Reason: To safeguard the amenities of the adjoining premises and the area generally in accordance with the requirements of policies CS5 and CS7 of the



London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Core Strategy and policy DP26, DP28 and DP12 of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Development Policies.
