FRONT EXTERNAL ELEVATION

Camera One (Front Elevation)

BAN-D-VF-1080 high definition vandal resistant IP (1920 x 1080) external dome colour camera supplied with 2.8 - 12 mm varifocal lens (viewing angle 98 - 30 degrees) and LED lighting with a range of 18 metres. This surface mounted white finish camera is to be fitted: front elevation, high level on the right side viewing the windows entrance to offices 6,5,4 &3.

This camera is to be wall mounted with a bracket.

Camera Two (Front Elevation)

BAN-D-VF-1080 high definition vandal resistant IP (1920 x 1080) external dome colour camera supplied with 2.8 - 12 mm varifocal lens (viewing angle 98 - 30 degrees) and LED lighting with a range of 18 metres. This surface mounted white finish camera is to be fitted: front elevation, adjacent to office entrance 4 viewing court yard.

This camera is to be wall mounted with a bracket.

Camera Three (Front Elevation)

BAN-D-VF-1080 high definition vandal resistant IP (1920 x 1080) external dome colour camera supplied with 2.8 - 12 mm varifocal lens (viewing angle 98 - 30 degrees) and LED lighting with a range of 18 metres. This surface mounted white finish camera is to be fitted: front elevation, adjacent office entrance 3 viewing entrance & windows to offices 2 & 1.

This camera is to be wall mounted with a bracket.

Camera Four (Front Elevation)

BAN-D-VF-1080 high definition vandal resistant IP (1920 x 1080) external dome colour camera supplied with 2.8 - 12 mm varifocal lens (viewing angle 98 - 30 degrees) and LED lighting with a range of 18 metres. This surface mounted white finish camera is to be fitted: front elevation, high level on the left side viewing the arch entrance to bicycles.

This camera is to be wall mounted with a bracket.

REAR EXTERNAL ELEVATION

Camera Five (Left Side Rear Bicycle Elevation)

BAN-D-VF-1080 high definition vandal resistant IP (1920×1080) external dome colour camera supplied with 2.8 - 12 mm varifocal lens (viewing angle 98 - 30 degrees) and LED lighting with a range of 18 metres. This surface mounted white finish camera is to be fitted: left side rear bicycle elevation, in the bicycle storage area storage area & electrics cupboards.

This camera is to be wall mounted with a bracket.

Camera Six (Rear Elevation)

Camera Eight (Front Elevation)

BAN-MD-F4-1080 high definition vandal resistant IP (1920 x 1080) external mini dome colour camera supplied with 4 mm fixed lens (viewing angle 79 degrees) and LED lighting with a range of 20 metres. This surface mounted white finish camera is to be fitted: front elevation, ceiling mounted viewing the front door to communal stairs 1.

This camera is to be wall mounted with a bracket.

Camera Nine (Front Elevation)

BAN-MD-F4-1080 high definition vandal resistant IP (1920 x 1080) external mini dome colour camera supplied with 4 mm fixed lens (viewing angle 79 degrees) and LED lighting with a range of 20 metres. This surface mounted white finish camera is to be fitted: front elevation, ceiling mounted viewing the front door to communal stairs 2.

This camera is to be wall mounted with a bracket.

Camera Ten (Front Elevation)

BAN-MD-F4-1080 high definition vandal resistant IP (1920 x 1080) external mini dome colour camera supplied with 4 mm fixed lens (viewing angle 79 degrees) and LED lighting with a range of 20 metres. This surface mounted white finish camera is to be fitted: front elevation, ceiling mounted viewing the front door to communal stairs 3.

This camera is to be wall mounted with a bracket.

Network Video Recording Unit

A BAN-S-NVR-8TB Network Video Recording unit with centralized surveillance interface software for the management of IP cameras, to be installed ELECTRICS CUPBOARD. The NVR, which is supplied with eight CCTV licences, provides live images whilst recording in high definition, offers remote network access and allows events to be played back whilst the unit continues to record. This high speed recording unit, which streams multiple HD images, reproduces extremely clear and detailed images when viewed on a monitor or over a LAN network. Recorded events can be retrieved from the unit via one of the high speed 3.0 USB ports. The unit will record images when motion is detected at a frame rate of 25fps for approximately 30 days before the hard disc is overwritten and will allow the client to share and access the CCTV images remotely from any web browser on a Mac, Windows PC (up to version 7), iPhone, iPad, Android or Blackberry, when connected to a router. Size: 157H x 103.5W x 232D mm

NVR Router

We will replace the router issued with the broadband connection with a high end DrayTek Vigor 2860 router.

Viewing The Images

No monitor is required with the Network Video Recording unit as the client will view the images on their iPad (or suitable tablet), iPhone (or suitable smartphone) laptop, PC or Mac.

PoE Switch

A Netgear FS726TP twenty four port multicast and VLAN compatible switch, with twelve PoE ports is to be fitted adjacent to the network video recording unit.

Electrical Requirements

Our engineers will provide a surge protected 6 gang extension lead for the NVR, Visual Station, monitor and PoE switch. The client is to provide a double outlet 13-amp socket in the location of the NVR.

Cable & Containment (Client)

Banham will supply all cable to site for the client's electrician to first fix.

FIRST FIX OF CABLES

CAT 5 CABLE TO BE RUN TO ALL REQUIRED POSITIONS BY CLIENTS BUILDERS BACK TO THE RECORDING UNIT. THIS UNIT WILL BE CONNECTED TO A ROUTER SET UP WITH A STATIC BROADBAND IP ADDRESS FOR OFF SITE VIEWING ON ANY VIEWING DEVICE.

Off-Site Viewing

Please note that our installation allows for up to two mobile devices, such as smartphones or tablets, to be set up free of charge, thereby allowing the client to view their CCTV images off-site. Should the client require additional mobile devices or computers (e.g. Windows PC or Mac) to be connected, Banham will charge £150.00 per hour.

To allow off-site access to the CCTV images the client will need to provide the following:

- A permanent Internet connection with a static IP address
- Sufficient upload bandwidth with low jitter and latency
- A fairly recent Apple iPod/iPhone/iPad, Android, Windows PC/Laptop or Apple Mac(Book)
- All mobile devices at the same location as the installation
- Passwords for your devices including the router, Apple Store, Google Play Store and any computers

In addition we suggest replacing any free-issue router (such as a BT HomeHub) as third party updates may remove the required configuration for remotely viewing CCTV images. A quality router will generally improve the speed and reliability of the network and prevent any third party automatic updates from resetting the configuration.

Where the client would rather have their IT company/consultant connect the devices for remote viewing or add any new devices, please note that Banhamprovide all connection details and necessary viewing software.

Please note that when any networked equipment is supplied or configured by any Group company, no responsibility will be accepted for loses, damages or labour which may result either at the time of installation or at any time during the equipment's operational lifetime. The client is responsible for network security, backups and other forms of system administration. Where equipment is replaced under warranty, during an upgrade or due to other circumstances, the client should ensure the security and integrity of their network, performing any monitoring and/or auditing they deem fit.

General Notes Residential

Please refer to the specification and the data sheets regarding the positioning of devices and, for information on how to achieve the maximum benefits from your system.

Where systems are being taken over or upgraded, the existing CCTV system may be non-operational whilst the new work is being carried out and, that you may need to make alternative security arrangements which suits both you and your insurer.

All cameras are designed to operate in low light levels, however it may be necessary to install additional lighting to enhance visibility.

Unless otherwise stated, the view from the cameras will show a wide angle general picture of the areas (monitoring or detecting), which will not necessarily provide facial recognition/identification.

An output can be provided to allow the client's television engineer to connect the CCTV system to the client's television system.

Where remote access is a requirement, we would recommend that the client contacts an IT consultant to arrange for the Digital Video Recording unit to be configured for viewing over the internet.

For systems that are required to be viewed off-site, it is the client's responsibility to arrange the installation of an Internet connection with a static IP address which should, if possible, be installed in the same location as the Video Recorder. Please note the company cannot be held responsible for any failure, reconfiguration and/or update to the CCTV system, the client's router or the clients devices which have been performed by someone other than our engineer. We are also not responsible for fault, failure or any limitations which may be applied to the clients Internet connection in the future, e.g. latency, bandwidth or blocks.

Where the un-switched mains fused spur is fitted by Banham, the fused spur will be installed by a Competent Person in accordance with the Electricity at Work Regulations 1989 and BS7671 2001. If the client requires a Minor Works Certificate for the installation we can arrange the certification of the fused spur at an additional cost.
