To who ever is dealing with this application to fell a tree in my garden at 207d Belsize Road,

I only returned home a few days ago to find the letter of objection sent 15May. None of my neighbours appear to have recieved one! I already sent an objection about the felling of this tree last year. I heard nothing. This tree was granted a preservation order some years back. How can that be recinded?

The most recent leter recieved says comments will be published on the 1 April 2013!!

The tree is loved by all of the immediate nieghbours, with the exception of one shop keeper. The lady from a duvet shop at 205 Belsize Road. She says it blocks the sun from her back basement area and rear shop windo. She has gone behind my back several time, getting private tree felling companies to fell it. That is why I got the TPO in the first place.

This tree brings lots of wildlife (birds and butterflies) into the area. It shades the gardens beautifully in the Summer. It is a very lovely looking tree, All the nieghbours love it, and none I know of, want it felled.

This tree does no damage to any of the immediate buildings. I do accept there is some minor movement of brick work to the basement access. This does not justify killing the tree. It can be trim at the crown, and if nessesary the roots can also be trimmed.

Please hold this application so that I can make all my nieghbours aware of what is going on here. I am sure that if they had recieved the same letter, most would want to object to the tree being killed off.
