Planning Application Number 2015/2607/P

Reasons for objections:

1. My partner is a piano concert performer and would not be able to practise due to the noise while the building works are progressing.

2. The lady who lives downstairs is employed as a piano accompanist for the senior pupils of the two main musical schools in London. A lot of her work takes place during the evening hours and she practises at home during daytime. In her experience she wouldn't be able to do so if the noise of the building work proceeds uncontrolled. She says that she may have to leave 39A Gayton road for this reason.

We are all concerned that if permission is granted for the building work to proceed over a significant period of time, without restrictions, it will significantly impair the professional needs of these two ladies.

3. As the resident of 39 Gayton Road during the past 45 years and owner of this property, I am particularly concerned that the adjacent garden is dug out to a level below that of the foundations of my house. There is evidence that similar work in nearby areas has led to severe damage of adjacent properties. Unexpected holes in the road surfaces sometimes appear. This confirms the unpredictable nature of the soil underneath these surfaces. The risk of unstable foundations is accentuated if the level of the adjacent areas is lowered. I also believe that by agreeing to any extension of support within and underneath my property would make me a willing participant in this wholly unsatisfactory activity.
