I am writing as a local resident. Whilst I don't necessarily object to the phone/ATM in principle, there are some comments I would like to make in relation to this application:

1. Environmental impact: There is a risk that street installations like this will contribute further to street noise, loitering and disturbance which is a well-established and serious issue in Camden Town
2. Current provision of ATMs: There are already nearby ATMs at the Co-Op and next door to the Dublin Castle.
3. External Design: The design of this phone box with its promotional advertising is very loud and intrusive for a conservation area. If permission is granted, could the design be "toned down" so it is more in-keeping with the local area's Conservation Area status?
