I object to the proposed work referred to above on the grounds that the increased height & over development of the building will impact adversely on my home, reducing natural light, increasing overlooking & noise from its multiple flats & occupants.

In addition, the outgoing previous developers had agreed at several meetings with residents on certain specific conditions to ensure minimal disturbance to our homes, thus obtaining planning permission without our objection. The new developers have given us no such assurances.

Furthermore, the latest design is not in context with neighbouring Holland & Thurstan Dwellings' planted courtyards & ivy covered walls. A greener concept with trees screening the short space between two buildings + a living green roof atop the lower social housing section had been promised - none of which has been upheld by the new developers.
