2015/2702/P	G Khatun	17a Monmouth Street London WC2H 9DD	29/06/2015 10:41:36	OBJ	<p>This is to object to the planning application as it will have a direct impact on me.</p> <p>I was alerted to this planning application and it concerns me directly on 17/06/2015 when the landlord sought access to my property in order to meet with the planning officer on 19/06/2015.</p> <p>I understand that it is to install air conditioning in the shop and there will be a vent out into the rear.</p> <p>The air conditioning is proposed:-</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1) Rear of the shop which is inside my front door - I have a door at street level and another door on the 1st floor (my property is 1-3rd floor of 17 Monmouth Street)</li> <li>2) The air conditioning will be adjacent to my front door in an enclosed space which is only accessed by me. The front door is my only entry / exit out of my property</li> <li>3) In front of my door on the 1st floor, there is a very small space, I use this as my garden as this is the only outside space I have</li> </ol> <p>I am against the application because an air conditioning system will interfere with the quality of my life and quality of living in my property as:-</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. I am an elderly person in my 70's</li> <li>2. I have lived in my property for the last c48 years</li> <li>3. I am of ill health, house bound and I am disabled</li> <li>4. I suffer from arthritis, diabetics, Alzheimer's, anxiety, have issues with my eyes and previously had a by pass. I have a carer due to my ill health</li> <li>5. I can no longer manage the stairs and cannot go outside hence the outside space / garden is very important to me and is used regularly</li> <li>6. Having an air conditioning system will affect my health further with the hot / cold air, noise, vibration etc</li> <li>6. I believe the compressed air that will be released through the vent will rise up and because of the confined space (which is in a rectangular box shape) my garden is within I will not be able to enjoy my garden peacefully. Also I will not be able to enjoy the fresh air / will make the air quality poor</li> <li>8. The air conditioning may release chemicals which I will be inhaling in directly</li> <li>9. Once the air conditioning unit gets old / in the longer term the noise, vibration etc can get louder</li> <li>10. If it is replaced in the future it can be a very powerful unit</li> <li>11. Access to my property may be difficult if there is hot / cold air, also I am advised I will need to give access to the tenants in the shop in order for them to maintain the unit. This is a security issue for me because of my vulnerability</li> <li>12. On many previous occasions it was attempted to fit a vent for the air conditioning which I have strongly resisted</li> </ol> <p>As mentioned above, I am not happy to have an air conditioning system / louvred doorway.</p>
