


EXISTING EAST ELEVATION

TYPE D1 WINDOW - SECTION NOTE: Any gaps between window and brick reveals are to be tightly packed with oakum and pointed up with hydraulic lime mortar to finish. -Existing timber window retained and Overhaul. Remove/brush off all loose dirt, defective paint and loose putty. Chemical peel-off and low pressure rinse. Make surface good. New putty glazed casements. Ease & adjust. Three coats of oil paint colour TBC. Any gaps at jambs/heads to be filled with lime mortar (to general specification) and/or New opening casements to replace existing modern fixed glazing. Fit draft/weatherstripping
