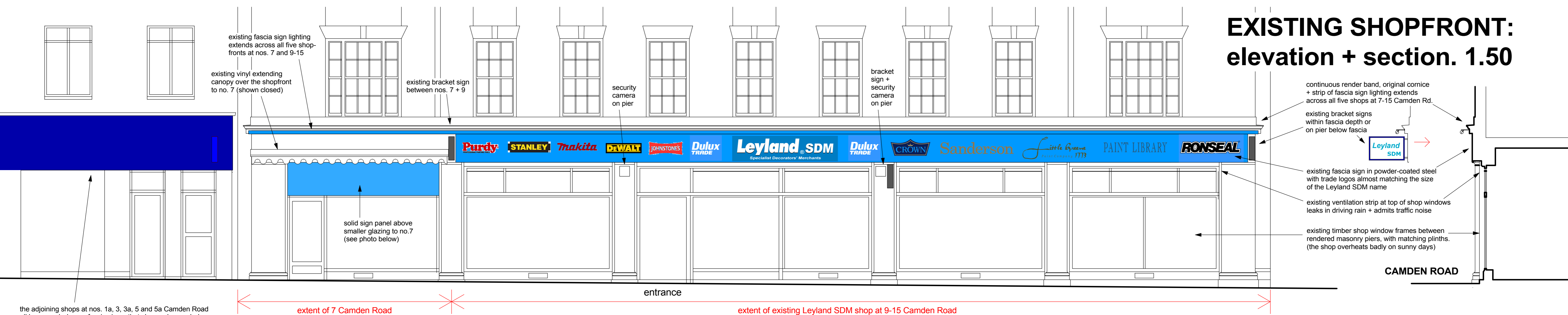
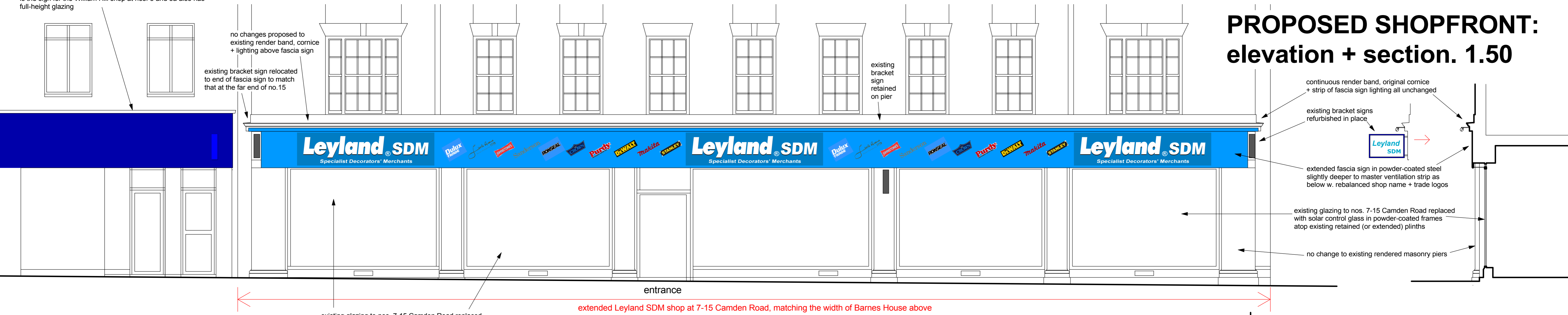


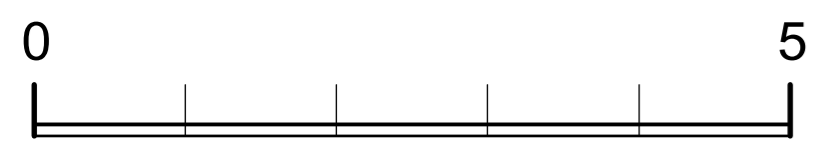
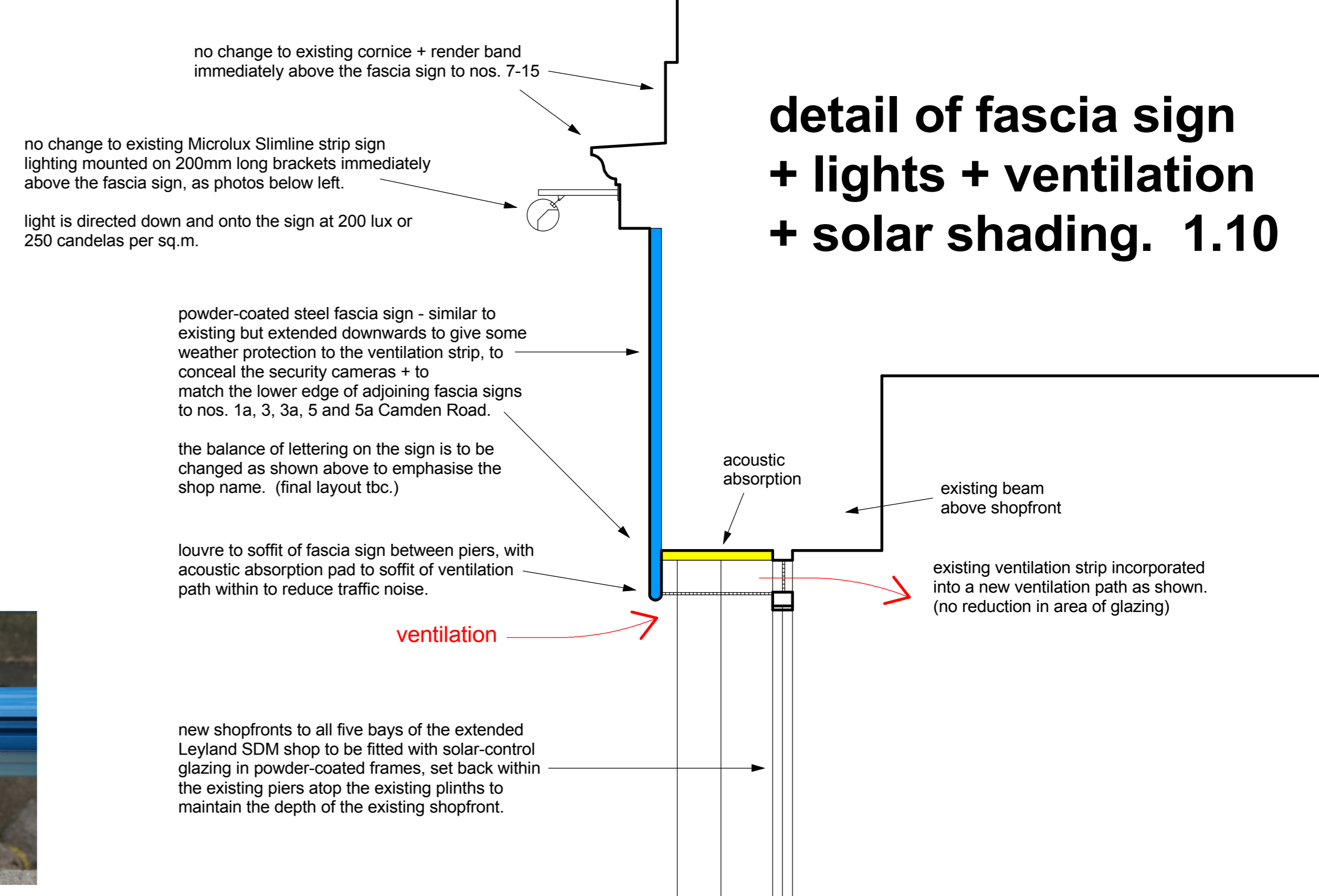
## EXISTING SHOPFRONT: elevation + section. 1.50

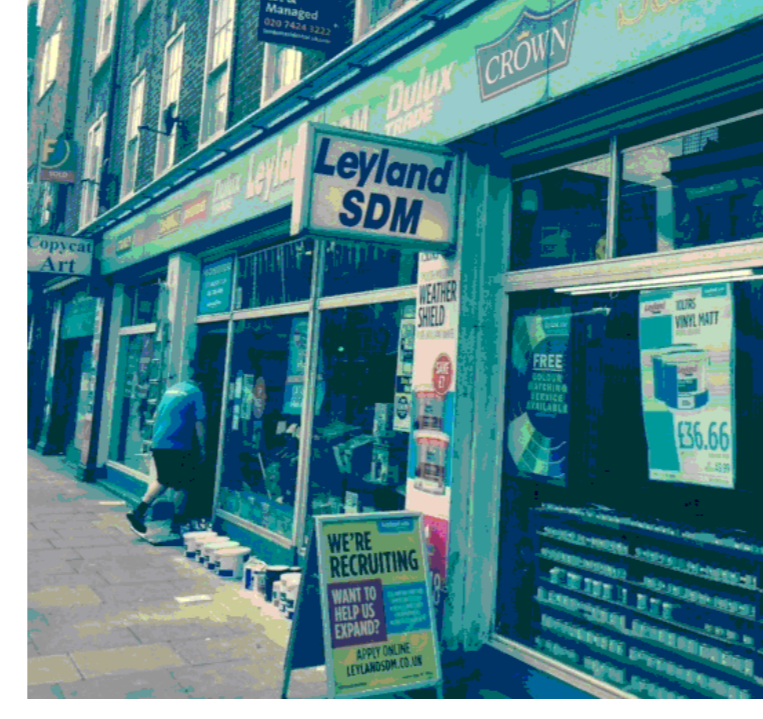
