Planting proposal:

Plants proposed for planting either side of garden room; rear garden 101a Gloucester Avenue, London NW1 8 LB:

To be set in 300mm trenches post completion to Garden Room works, with connection and extension to existing garden drip irrigation system.

4no. x 7.5lt Hydrangea petiolaris @ height of 60cm to start.

4no. x 5lt Parthenocissus Henryana @ height of 90-120cm to start.

(* 2no. of each species to either side of shed)

Nb: Approved installed trellis to garden walls is at height of 1.8m to provide instant screens to garden and adjacent private amenity spaces.

- Species suitable to grow and climb in heavy shaded areas.
- Species will 'top-up' previously planted climbers set outside extremities of Garden Room and encouraged towards installed trellis screening along full depth of Proposed Garden Room.

Protection to All existing trees onsite:

- 2no. existing trees to have temporary hoarding installed to below underside of crown (and to outside diameter of crown), with root diameter of 1.2m shown on drawings, with all ground works to occur outside this area.
- -Nb: a stock brick dwarf wall has been constructed around Ino. existing tree (the largest on the site) during mains works to the main house as added protection.
