The Council has considered your application and decided to **refuse** planning permission for the following reason(s):

Reason(s) for Refusal

1 The unauthorised antennas and associated equipment, by reason of their siting, scale and appearance are considered to have a detrimental impact on the character and appearance of the Bloomsbury Conservation Area and the listed building on which they are located, therefore contrary to policy CS14 (Promoting high quality places and conserving our heritage) of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Core Strategy and policy DP24 (Securing high quality design), DP25 (Conserving Camden's heritage) of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Development Policies.



In dealing with the application, the Council has sought to work with the applicant in a positive and proactive way in accordance with paragraphs 186 and 187 of the National Planning Policy Framework.

ENFORCEMENT ACTION TO BE TAKEN

The Council has authorised the Planning Department to instruct the Borough Solicitor to issue an Enforcement Notice alleging breach of planning control.
