- The facing materials to be used on the glazed pavilion shall not be otherwise than as shall have been submitted to and approved by the Council before any work on the site is commenced.
- No development shall take place until full details of hard and soft landscaping scheme for the sunken garden areas have been submitted to and approved by the Council.
- Details of the means by which refuse will be stored on site prior to collection shall have been submitted to and approved by the Council before any work on the site is commenced. Such details shall be fully implemented and retained permanently.

Reasons for additional conditions:

- 1 To safeguard the amenities of the adjoining premises and the area generally.
- To ensure that the Council may be satisfied with the external appearance of the building.
- In order that the Council may give consideration to the details of the proposed development.
- 4 To safeguard the amenities of the adjoining premises and the area generally.
