The Council has considered your application and decided to refuse planning permission for the following reason(s):

### Reason(s) for Refusal

1 The development, by reason of its design, scale, bulk and location, has a detrimental impact on the character and appearance of the Camden Town conservation area, on the appearance and setting of the host listed building and on the setting of the wider terrace of listed buildings. As such the proposal is contrary to policies CS5 (Managing the impact of growth and development) and CS14 (Promoting high quality places and conserving our heritage) of the London Borough of Local Development Framework Camden Core Strategy and policies DP24 (Securing high quality design) and DP25 (Conserving Camden's heritage) of London Borough of



Camden Local Development Framework Development Policies.
