I am writing to oppose the planning application above. Particularly:

1. The overall scale of the proposed development is much larger than existing and would detrimentally alter the character of Redington Gardens.
2. The proposed felling of trees.
3. Architecture is not fitting.
4. The basement extension is inappropriate.

I have only been roughly over the plans so the above points are not an exhaustive list of objections. I'm sure there would be many more if I had the time to explore them.

I would also like to raise an official complaint against the planning process. I received a "flyer" in my post box earlier this year about a meeting to discuss the redevelopment of 25/26 Redington Gardens. It did not say who from and I would be away on the meeting date.
