The proposed shopfront design is too modern and “sleek” (as the applicant describes it) and is not in keeping with the historic nature and character of the building, Neal Street or the conservation area. The applicant should be required to propose a more traditional shopfront, as required in the Seven Dials Renaissance Study, which Camden adopted for planning purposes. The study specifically references the shopfront of 29 Neal Street.
