The dormer proposed for the street elevation is far too large, much larger than that which already exists and even larger than the large nearby- dormers.

Excessively large and varied dormers have spoilt many pleasant terraces of houses in the Hampstead Conservation Area – and this is no exception.

The large size of this proposed dormer is totally out of scale with the pleasant street elevation under.

It spoils the elevation and the terrace.

A dormer no larger than and matching that on no.27 might be considered satisfactory, however.
