Prune Robinia "frisia" (ID# 2) located at the rear of house according to the following specifications:

Clean to remove all dead, diseased and broken branches 2 centimetres in diameter and larger throughout crown to improve health and appearance and reduce risk of branch failure.
Reduce regrowth back to previous points by approximately 2-2.5 metres to reduce risk of branch, stem and/or root failure.

Prune Eucalyptus (ID# 1) located at the rear of house according to the following specifications:

reduce back branch in upper crown growing over neighbours garden by 2m
Prune Cherry (ID# 4) located at the back of property according to the following specifications:
Clean to remove all dead, diseased and broken branches 2 centimetres in diameter and larger throughout crown to improve health and appearance and reduce risk of branch failure.
Reduce crown height and spread by approximately 1-1.5 metres to enhance natural form.
Prune Escallonia (ID# 7) located at the back of property according to the following specifications:

Reduce height by approximately 1-1.5 metres to enhance natural form and contain.
Prune Lilac (ID# 6) located at the back of property according to the following specifications:
Renovate shrub by removing approximately 20% of stems. Prune remaining stems as necessary with the objective to reduce size and enhance natural or desired form.

• Old woody stems only retaining new growth
