We object to this proposal for the following reasons:

The installation of railings on the first floor rear balcony would make it a usable space and lead to overlooking of both neighbours' properties.

Likewise, the installation of railings on the roof would make it a space for parties etc which would be an antisocial use in such a tightly packed residential area.
Railings on roofs are not a characteristic feature in these listed terraces.

We were shocked to see that the house has a full width, glass fronted extension. Do you know when this was granted planning permission?
