With reference to the above planning application, I should like to state the following:

The building in 31 Heath Drive, was seriously affected by subsistence about eight years ago requiring extensive underpinning and remedial work. This caused great stress and inconvenience to all concerned. At the announcement that our neighbours on the ground intend to undertake the extension of the existing basement and alterations at ground floor level and the creation of new openings, this has become a source of serious concern for us given the potential danger that exists for subsidence to reoccur.
