Dear Sir or Madam,

We are writing on behalf of the Camden Town CAAC.

We strongly object to the felling of the two plane trees behind Nos 46-50 Parkway and No 52 Parkway. Although the two trees are actually sited in the back gardens of Gloucester Crescent, which are in the Primrose Hill CAAC, the trees overlook the back yards of the Parkway properties as well as the Cavendish School. The trees are splendidly luxuriant and help to improve the tatty back yards of the Parkway flats and shops. The arboreal consultant has said that the roots of the trees are undermining the interiors of the back extensions of the properties. Judging by the photographs, these extensions seem to be very neglected. They should be repaired and decorated to see if the roots have actually damaged the interiors in any way and new cracks appear.
