Both would be wholly out of character. The rear elev 52-48 Lambs Conduit Street (not in any photo or drawing submitted) present a cohesive Georg elevation consisting of identical, symmetrical sash windows on consistent elevations. There are window across 3 levels and 3 elevations. The third floor elevation has, characteristically, sligh smaller sashes at each elevation. Introducing a larger outward opening French window plus Jubalcony on this 3rd level on one elevation would be insensitive to the character of these building terms of type, size and design. It would destroy the uniformity (vertical and horizontal) of the windows on these buildings which is one of the key features of this Conservation area.
