					My son Jordan was diagnosed with cancer in February 2015 and is still receiving treatment. It is with deep concern that I write to you as the father of a son battling cancer whilst having to worry about the effects of these masts just yards away, whilst asleep at night trying to recover from one of the most devastating diseases and treatments an 18 year old can endure.
