The proposed works will fundamentally change the appearance of what is a particularly attractive brickwork block and typical of the mid 1950's. This is a friendly and supportive neighbourhood and the community would be traumatised by the change in character of their homes. The freehold properties in the close are not to be clad and there will also be an unattractive contrast between the two. The increase in door and window recess will significantly reduce the natural light into the flats. The cladding will damage the existing 1950's brickwork and in addition it only has a lifespan of at best 30 years and at some point the whole system will have to be replaced causing further damage to the original structure.
