DECISION

Planning (Listed Building and Conservation Areas) Act 1990

Listed Building Consent Granted

34 Downshire Hill London NW3 1NU

Proposal:

Installation of 2 x air conditioning units on side extension roof; replacement of 1 x sash window at rear first floor level with new window to match existing; demolition of brick wall at lower ground floor level and replacement with new brick wall; and waterproofing membrane to existing front vaults.

The Council has considered your application and decided to grant Listed Building Consent subject to the following condition(s):

Conditions And Reasons:

1 The development hereby permitted must be begun not later than the end of three



years from the date of this permission.

Reason: In order to comply with the provisions of Section 91 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 (as amended).

2 All new work and work of making good shall be carried out to match the original work as closely as possible in materials and detailed execution.

Reason: In order to safeguard the special architectural and historic interest of the building in accordance with the requirements of policy CS14 of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Core Strategy and policy DP25 of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Development Policies.

3 The works hereby approved are only those specifically indicated on the drawing(s) referred to above.

Reason: In order to safeguard the special architectural and historic interest of the building in accordance with the requirements of policy CS14 of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Core Strategy and policy DP25 of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Development Policies.

Informative(s):

The rear sash window would be partly restored with the bottom sash to be replaced to match. The development would return original features back to the Grade II listed building that had been lost over time. As a result, the proposal is considered to preserve the setting and the features of special architecture of the listed building. The air conditioning units would be located within a timber surround of a smaller footprint and height than the existing cold water store and are considered an improvement on the current situation. The replacement of the structurally unsound wall in front of the existing vaults would see the loss of some historic fabric, but the development is not considered to harm the special architectural and historic interest of the Listed Building.

The proposed works are considered relatively minor in nature and would not adversely impact on the setting of the listed building or the character or appearance of the conservation area. Overall, the external and internal alterations to the listed building would not cause a material level of harm to its significance and are acceptable.

The site's planning history has been taken into account when coming to this decision.

Special regard has been attached to the desirability of preserving the listed building and its features of special architectural or historic interest, under s.16 of the Listed Buildings and Conservation Areas Act 1990 as amended by the Enterprise and Regulatory Reform Act (ERR) 2013.

As such, the proposed development is in general accordance with policies CS14 of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Core Strategy, and policy DP25 of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Development Policies. The proposed development also accords with policy 7.8 of the London Plan 2011; and paragraphs 14, 17, 56-66 and 126-141 of the National Planning Policy Framework.
