Dear Sir

Traffic and parking issues are my serious concerns about this project.

Barrett's are currently building 128 residences with more than half without a parking space. This new KCL development, proposes 156 residences with only 97 parking spaces. All the occupants of these homes, with or without a car-spaces, will make car journeys (taxis, rented cars, visitors). Additionally, there are all the "services" and delivery vehicles clogging this road

Kidderpore Avenue is already a well-used road, without the additional traffic that these two developments will generate. What any traffic survey of this road will not show, are the daily stand-offs that occur with parking on both sides of the road leaving a single lane for 2-way traffic.

Either provide ample off-street parking in the development/s to relieve the street parking chaos, or make the road one way to ensure free traffic-flow and ensure essential services are not hindered.

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
