As a frequent visitor to 10 Pilgrims Lane, Hampstead, NW3 1SL, I have written and sent emails to your department in relation to Planning Application 2012/5825/P which sought approval to excavate a basement to 8 Pilgrims Lane. I notified your department of my change of postal and email addresses when my wife and I moved from Gloucestershire last year, but just in case you do not have those details, they are Brookview, St Johns Street, Bicester, Oxfordshire, OX26 6SG [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]

I know from an email sent recently from [PlanningAppeals@camden.gov.uk](mailto:PlanningAppeals@camden.gov.uk) to the email address my wife used when we lived in Gloucestershire that Appeal 2012/5825/P will be the subject of a public local inquiry later this year.

I understand that the appellant has now submitted Applications 2015/4053P and 2015/4157P under a "permitted development" procedure. I gather that these new applications differ only slightly from 2012/5825/P and fail in several respects to be fit for approval. Crucially, the "new" proposals involve the same extreme danger to the supporting columns of 10 Pilgrims Lane. It seems sensible, therefore, and indeed, I understand is mandatory, for the new applications to be placed on hold until the outcome of the public inquiry. I urge your department to do this and to register, please, my strong objections to Applications 2015 4053/P and 4157/P.
