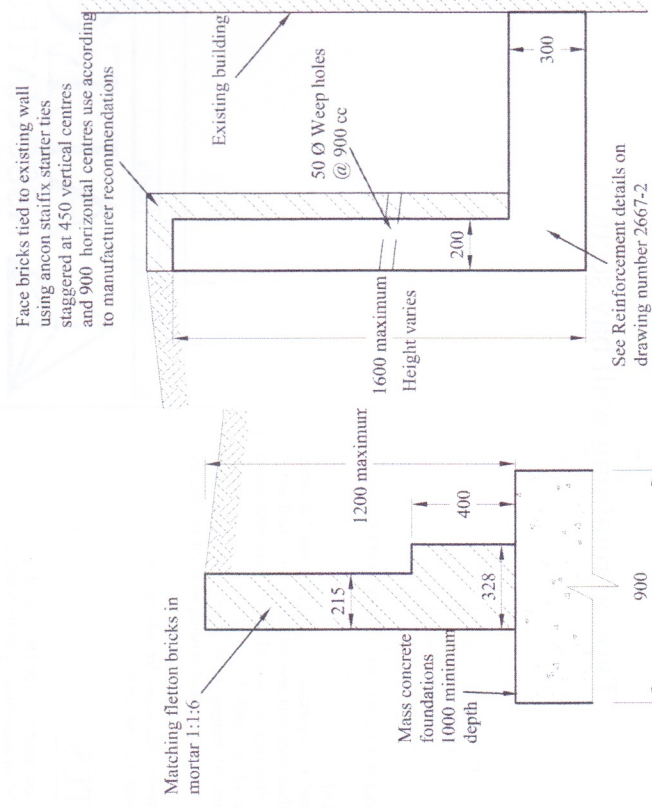
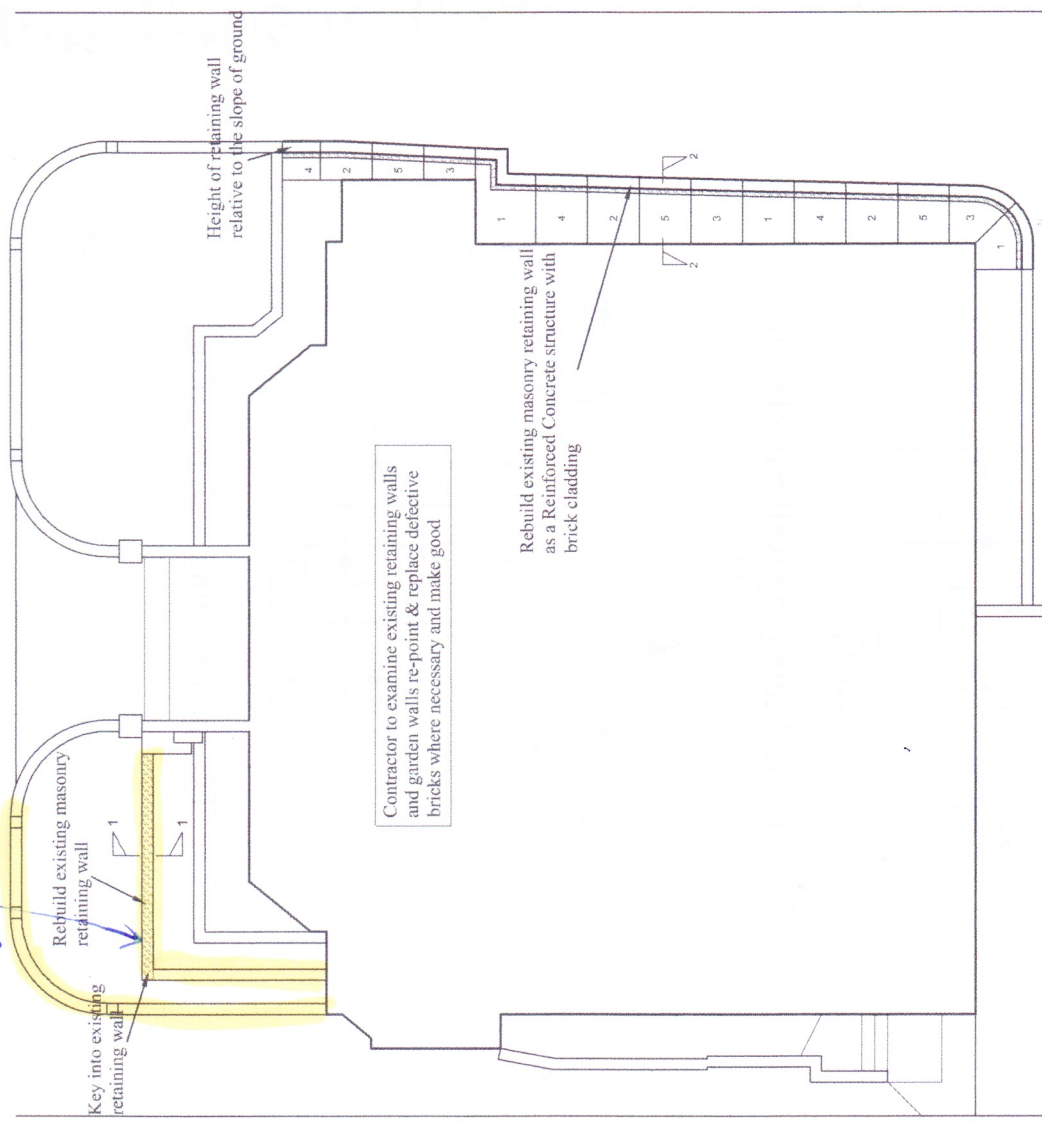


Walls already repaired

SUGGESTIVE CONSTRUCTION SEQUENCE

1. Divide length of wall to be constructed into bays of maximum length 1000. Construct bays in the order 1 3 5 2 4 1 3 5 ... so as not to have to work on bays adjacent to bays just completed.
2. Place H12 x 600 mm bars into each unconcreted side for continuity between bays. Concrete must be compacted with a 50 mm poker vibrator. Wait a minimum of 24 hours before working on adjacent bays.
