Rear Garden:

Thuja Plicata: Approximately 15.00m. This fine tree forms good screen but is now a little tall. Reduce height by approximately 20% or 2.50m. Bay: Approximately 12.00m. This large multi stemmed tree has not been pruned for many years. Although attractive it has become much too large for its location and is causing the garden to feel dark. Reduce crown height back to previous reduction points, approximately 30-40%. Reduce lateral and sub lateral side growth as is practicable by approximately 20-25% whilst preserving a healthy amount of foliage cover.
