The structures are attached to the front of this Grade 2 Georgian building, not the rear which simply consists of a plain brick wall onto Stamford Close. The main entrance is from Hampstead Square, through the garden to the front porch, attached to which is now this bin store. The store could easily be located elsewhere in the garden, but if permitted would provide a footprint for further development, as has been the history with this property. The trellis is also considerably higher than the adjoining fence, and the effect of the whole is unwieldy. It is unsympathetic to the Georgian house, and detracts from its architectural integrity. My living room and bedroom windows look directly onto the front of No 4. I have taken a photo of the structures which I have attached to a separate email to the Planning Departmentt, and I would like it considered as it gives a clearer view than that submitted by the agent. In my view the architectural demerits of these structures and the harm done to the look of the listed building mean that these structures should be removed.
