The proposed extension is on the same level as my bedroom, bathroom and back yard. The distance between the wall which separates our two properties (yards) and my bedroom window is 10ft 6ins, and between the wall and my bathroom is 6ft 5ins. This wall between our two yards currently stands at 4ft 6.5ins high. The proposed extension would raise this wall so high it would block the natural daylight into my property in particular my bedroom, bathroom and yard. As my basement & ground floor residence is surrounded on three sides by 5-storey high buildings, it already suffers from reduced natural light. Building the proposed extension thus raising the wall between the two properties will make my small back yard feel like a prison yard. I also object to the ground floor window being replaced by french doors. My concerns are that the flat roof of the extension may be used in the future as a roof garden and not solely for maintenance access. Therefore I may lose more light and privacy into my ground floor kitchen which is above my bedroom. I am also concerned at the two stack pipes which currently serve the 3 flats directly above 17 Millman Street and drain into No.17's back yard. It is not clear that if the extension is built, will the the pipes need to be redirected into my back yard? If the plans are approved and the extension is built, my living conditions will suffer. For these reasons
