As residents in Flask Walk (No 61) my wife and I would like to add our voices to the protests about the application to build a basement at No 36. This plan constitutes an enormous over-development of a narrow property that will yield very little extra living space at the price of much disruption for this part of Flask Walk. The disruption to traffic has been seriously underestimated in the application. Though the difficulties of other types of traffic have been noted, no mention has been made about how the refuse trucks on their Monday collection will get past the builder's skip and other equipment required for a complicated excavation and construction. Nor is their any provision for space to put steel beams, bricks and concrete supplies needed for the extension. The builders cannot expect all these materials to be delivered on an 'as required' basis.
