The proposed scale of the works is out of all proportion to the character of the delicate listed building. It is also out of character with ten surrounding buildings within the heart of the Hampstead Village conservation area. It is also of prior aesthetic design.  B. There is extensive damage to the ground water drainage of surrounding properties at the top of Hampstead Hill causing knock on effects further down the hill for neighbouring properties.  C. The proposed works intrude onto a public footpath.  D. The HGV movements over an extended period of time through very narrow lanes would be a very serious noise and pollution nuisance to neighbours.
