T5 mature Bay in northern lawn bed to front of Gardeners sheds

- Reduce crown overall by approx. 20% (approx. 2-3m off branch ends) to create a more compact canopy size and reduce suppression to adjacent Acer and Plane trees.

- Maintaining shape and form at all times

T36 Mature Mulberry on grass area to front of Lincolns Inn New Hall (tag: 0971) encroaching on building

- Remove light growth back to main scaffold branches to provide approx. 1.5-2m clearance from building where possible

- Reduce longer protruding branches overhanging motorcycle parking area by approx. 2m back into the profile of the internal canopy

- Reduce longer protruding branches growing parallel with the building by approx. 2m back into the profile of the internal canopy

- Reduce other longer protruding branches where required back into the profile of the internal canopy to form a neat and rounded canopy form

T44 Mature London plane within Gatehouse Court with low crown not lifted in previous work

- Sensitively lift low crown all round to an even height of approx. 7-8m above ground to reduce issue of encroachment

- Prune to provide clearance from building on NE and E side of canopy, prune to clear building by approx. 2.5-3m where possible

- All cuts to be made to secondary growth points maintaining shape and form

T57 Mature Walnut at south end of South lawn

- Lift low crown to an even level all round to approx. 2.5m

T58 Mature Paulownia at south end of South lawn

- Lift low crown to an even level all round to approx. 2.5m

TG60 3no Gleditsia at south west end of south lawn overhanging bike parking racks

- Lift low crown to an even level to approx. 5m over road

T28 Semi mature London plane on edge of driveway overhanging north lawn with significant leaning habit due to suppression from taller established plane trees

- Dismantle in sections to a flat stump at near ground level

- Grind stump to approx. 200mm below ground level in readiness for re-turfing works
