**Class C Part 4 of Schedule 2 of the Town and Country Planning (General  
Permitted Development) Order 2015 ("the Order")**

You will be aware that we have been working with CfBT Schools Trust in relation to Abacus Belsize Primary School. In this regard we have identified a site in which the school will operate on a temporary basis.

The Secretary of State for the Department for Education ("the Secretary of State") hereby duly notifies the London Borough of Camden, in accordance with Class C Part 4 of Schedule 2 of the Order as follows:-

- That on 18 August 2015 the Secretary of State approved the site of Jubilee Waterside Centre, 105 Camley Street for use as a state-funded school for the purposes of Class C.2 (a) Part 4 of Schedule 2 of the Order.
- That the proposed opening date of Abacus Belsize Primary School from Jubilee Waterside Centre is 1 September 2015.

The school will operate from Jubilee Waterside Centre for three academic years and an application seeking change of use for the second and third academic years will be submitted in due course.
