I strongly object to this application.</p> <p>1) This building is the only one on the street that does not retain the original Victorian features. Currently the top floor flat(s) has/have large balconies and the residents quite often throw parties until late. The noise comes down directly onto this narrow one way street and we, living just across the road, get disturbed by it. Considering the residents' type in this building, an additional floor means more parties and it means more noise we need to deal with.</p> <p>2) This road has already more than enough on street parking cars for the residents and we always struggle to find a space. Creating more flats has a strong probability of more cars. Not only we will struggle more for the space but also we have to deal with noises associated with cars.</p> <p>3) Currently this particular building's height matches to other buildings and this at least helps maintain the appearance of this residential road. All other buildings on the street, built in Victorian era, seem the subject of some restrictions for alteration of the appearance including erection of an additional floor. I don't understand why this particular building is allowed to erect an additional floor, if the application ever gets granted.</p> |

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
