Dear Ms Simovic

Thank you for the letters and plans regarding the proposed additions and alterations at 17 Lambolle Road where I have occupied the first floor flat since June 1966. I have known Colin Campbell since December 1975 and Mary Pat (not Bett) Campbell since 1992. We have always been on the best of terms so there is no personal animosity in the objections to the proposed new works which I am about to put forward.

I am concerned about the proposed new terrace to be added to the sitting room upstairs. This room is directly above the room in my flat which I use as a study bedroom and my desk and computer is placed at the window so the proposed new terrace would be directly above my head when I am working. I do a lot of free lance research work which means I am sitting at the desk working on my word processor for lengthy periods of time. I can imagine that I should be disturbed by lots of alfresco gatherings and moon light parties taking place on the new terrace above my bedroom. I also think that a terrace over my study bedroom would cut out some of the day light coming into my room. The back of our house faces west and my room in the afternoons is a delight with the afternoon sun and sunsets and I should not appreciate my views being obscured by an overhanging terrace. There is only one big window in my room, the next window on the plan is the window of my bathroom, then next the other bog room occupied now by my great niece, also as a study bedroom.
