We are writing on behalf of the Camden Town CAAC.

We certainly approve the proposal to put dark grey tiles around the new entrance. The present white surround around the double doors is really unsightly. The only thing we object to is the boxing in of the window immediately above the entrance door and especially the trite sign saying 'Welcome to Camden Town'.

Our reasons for our objection is that this small curved 1930s building is a landmark building in Camden Town being on a prominent site at Britannia Junction. So we think that the recessed feature of the small window should be kept as part of the original design.

We do not object to the signs in Application 2015/3873/A
