• Furthermore, the proposed dormer window would be located approximately 20m away from the windows to the front elevation of no.24, in accordance with guidance set out in CPG6 (Amenity). This states that to ensure privacy, there should normally be a minimum distance of 18m between the windows of habitable rooms of different units that directly face each other (paragraph 7.4).
